CORPORATE TEAM EXPERIENCE



Rabbit Runaway Orphanage offers a unique experience for employees to experience the workings of a private animal rescue. Learn how the rescue started, its joys and challenges and the work it does in the community.

The Experience: We can offer this experience Mondays and Fridays from 10 am to 1 pm for a team of 4 to 8 employees.

- **10 am:** Meet at the Orphanage over morning tea for a talk and discussion with the operators, Judi & Bryce Inglis. How they started, and the joys and challenges of operating a private rescue run entirely by volunteers. Meet the health-challenged animals and hear about how they came into their care and the healthy animals they rehome.
- **11.00 am:** Your team will undertake a brief safety induction on rabbits before being immersed in some activities normally undertaken by volunteers, such as assisting with cleaning enclosures, gardening or other activities that take up the day-to-day activities of the rescue.
- **12.30 pm:** To finish the morning the team will have one on one time with the rabbits to pat and take photos to remember their experience.

The experience is \$600 (+GST). These funds go towards supporting your experience as well as the vet care for the animals in preparation for rehoming.

Summary

- Cost for the day is \$600 (+GST)
- Team size is 4-8 people
- Be over 18 years of age
- Have a willingness to work with animals
- Not have a fear of animals
- Have a basic level of fitness and the capacity to undertake physical work such as cleaning animal enclosures, gardening etc.
